

Supernatural woman of Ngāti Kuia*


Hinepoupou is renown in Te Tauihu and the wider Raukawakawa area for swimming across Te Moana o Raukawakawa to Rangitoto ki te Tonga.

Pūrākau recount Hinepoupou living in the North Island with her husband, Manini Pounamu and his brother Te Hiki Pāroa. She awoke to find they had abandoned her. Once she realises what has happened, she vows to swim home. Using her prowess in the art of karakia, she called on Kaikaiāwaro. Upon her return, she devised a plan to get utu (vengeance) on

her husband. There are a number of different versions of this pūrākau, but the essence remains the same. This waiata celebrates the illustrious Ngāti Kuia tipuna Hinepoupou and encourages us to be strong willed, resilient and always fight for what is right.

These are the lessons we learn from our heroine, Hinepoupou.

He hautipua a Hinepoupou nō te rohe o Te Moana o Raukawakawa. Nāna te Moana o Raukawakawa i kauria mai i Kāpiti ki Rangitoto.
